3. Perth Solar Co-op - This member-owned group boasts 4.9/5 stars on ProductReview . Their unique peer-to-peer monitoring system helps users compare energy outputs across similar homes in real-time.

The Price Tag Behind the Sunshine

"Why does a 6.6kW system cost \$5,200 in Baldivis but \$7,100 in Cottesloe?" I hear you ask. Location-based pricing isn't just about postcodes - it's about roof complexity, local council regulations, and even microclimates. Coastal installations often require marine-grade components, adding 12-15% to the total cost.

Here's something most solar reviews Perth won't tell you: The sweet spot for Perth homes isn't necessarily the biggest system. A 5kW system with quality microinverters often outperforms cheaper 10kW setups during our characteristic "blue sky heat" days.
